Here's a recap of the Japanese kanji and pronunciation for the numbers 1-10.

Numeral	Kanji	Hiragana	Romaji
1	一	いち	<i>ichi</i>
2	二	に	<i>ni</i>
3	三	さん	<i>san</i>
4	四	し / よん	<i>shi / yon</i>
5	五	ご	<i>go</i>
6	六	ろく	<i>roku</i>
7	七	しち / なな	<i>shichi / nana</i>
8	八	はち	<i>hachi</i>
9	九	く / きゅう	<i>ku / kyuu</i>
10	十	じゅう	<i>juu</i>
